

# Automated External Defibrillation (AED) and AED Requalification (AEDR)

For each minute that passes without defibrillation after the heart stops, the casualty's chance of survival falls by about 10%. Defibrillators are very simple to operate and no previous first aid training is required. This course gives people the confidence to act quickly and effectively in an emergency.

Crucially, this course will teach defibrillator operators how to perform CPR.

## Certification
