Our corporate packages have been inspired by the Cross of St John, the Amalfi Cross, which is worn on the uniform by every member of St John Ambulance around the world and is symbolic of St John Ambulance world-wide.

Every part of the cross has a meaning linked to the four cardinal virtues and the eight qualities of an effective first aider.











Platinum: The Wisdom Package £10k +

The four arms of the modern white cross that represents the Order of St John symbolise the Wisdom of the cardinal virtues: Prudence, Justice, Temperance and Fortitude.

We are seeking four Wisdom Partners to help us keep our fleet of ambulances on the road both now and in the future.

A Wisdom Partner will effectively 'adopt' a St John Ambulance. The Ambulances will be called after the four virtues:

Prudence, Justice, Temperance and Fortitude.

Badger Sponsor

Badgers take part in a lively programme, working towards their Super Badger Award. The programme has been developed to enable young people to learn important life skills in a fun and safe environment. Badgers can choose from fifteen subjects to help complete their award. These range from Creative and Active, to Healthy and Caring. Once a Badger has completed their membership paw, they move onto their bronze paw, which is awarded after completing three subjects. A further three subjects will gain the silver paw and another three for the gold paw. A Badger becomes a Super Badger when they have completed twelve subjects.





Cadet Sponsor

Aged between 10 and 17 years old, our Cadet units operate at St Martin or HQ in St Helier. Cadets are all about fun, adventure and community. Guided by youth leaders, Cadets take part in an interactive full programme, working towards their Grand Prior Award. The programme enables young people to learn important life skills and become good citizens in a fun, safe environment, with challenges and excitement appropriate to their age.

Cadet Educational Trip to Malta April 2021 - 2022

This educational visit to Malta for our senior Cadets is a valuable opportunity for our Cadets to visit the St John Cathedral and other iconic historical museums, also to integrate with the Malta Cadets, acting as Ambassadors for the Island of Jersey.
